



DDC Troubleshooting

Target Group

This course is designed for those responsible for the installation and /or maintenance of building automation systems.

Prerequisites

To attend this course a solid understanding of NW8000 operations and block architecture is required.

Description

This course introduces the building operator /programmer to the concepts of point wiring, network wiring, communication checkout, and troubleshooting the installation and operation of a building automation system. A controller network will be built and a variety of hardware inputs and outputs will be examined. In addition, point to point checks, software troubleshooting with control loop tuning, and diagnostic analysis will be discussed.
