



InVue Operations and Programming

Target Group

This course is designed for those requiring in-depth operation and setup programming on a legacy system or LON controllers and have added InVue.

Prerequisites

To attend this course a basic knowledge of the legacy system used is required.

Description

This course describes the operational and programming aspects of the NT graphic user interface designed to take advantage of the N8 and DMS legacy systems as well as LON systems. This Windows interface allows the user to view controller operation through graphic or text monitoring screens with the displayed information being either editable or over-rideable. This customized version of InTouch 7.1 uses special ActiveX wizards to enhance the interface with controllers.
